

**WORTH PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT**  
**BOARD OF TRUSTEES POLICY**  
**FACE-COVERINGS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING**

All persons over the age of two entering the Worth Public Library must wear a face-covering that covers the nose and mouth and must maintain six-foot social distancing from all other persons.

Reasonable accommodations such as curbside pickup and online resources are available to those who are medically prevented from or who refuse to wear a face-covering.

Those who refuse to wear a face-covering that covers the nose and mouth will not be permitted to enter the building.

Those inside the building who refuse to wear a face covering that covers the nose and mouth and/or maintain six-foot social distancing will be required to leave the building.

This policy will be lifted when the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) declares that the State has reached Phase 5 of the Restore Illinois plan and will be reinstated should the IDPH determine that the State must return to an earlier phase of the plan.

Authority: Illinois Statutes (75ILCS 16/30-55.55) authorize the Library Board “to exclude from the use of the library any person who willfully violates an ordinance or regulation prescribed by the Board.”
