Flag Display Policy

It is the policy of the Worth Public Library District that the Flag of the United States shall be displayed under the following Circumstances:

Section 1 The Worth Public Library District shall display the Flag of the United States in accordance with title 36 United States Code Chapter 10, et. al and Presidential Executive Orders except as otherwise provided in this policy.

<u>Section 2</u> The flag shall be lowered to half-staff under the circumstances described in the attached table.

Section 3 When the flag is to be displayed in accordance with Section 2 of this policy and the first or final days of display fall on a Sunday or a holiday and there is no staff member or board member available to raise or lower the flag, the flag shall be raised or lowered on the next available business day.

Any Illinois fallen soldier	From sunrise to sunset on the day of the funeral and 2 days preceding the funeral
National, State, or local periods of mourning	As decreed by National, State, or Local Authorities
